Lessons learned & conclusions

Wafer silicon PV module manufacturing costs below 1 €/Wp are feasible; compatible with “grid parity in most of Europe”

Lessons learned & conclusions

Finding the balance between partner interests and consortium interests (and: national / EU) is critical and perhaps the greatest challenge
